Wi-Fi Hotspots Available to Check Out at Suzette Brumleve Memorial Effingham Public Library Thanks to Koboldt Trust Grant

Effingham Public Library is pleased to announce that thanks to a \$2,000 grant from the Koboldt Trust it now has 10 Wi-Fi hotspots available to check out to library card holders.

The hotspot is a small pocket sized device that is able to connect to the internet in areas covered by the Sprint Network, you can connect your phone, tablet, etc. to access Wi-Fi. In fact you are able to connect up to 10 WI-FI-enabled devices to the Internet at one time using the Sprint LTE network.

Note: The hotspots will only connect to the internet in areas covered by the Sprint Mobile network. Library card holders can check out the hotspots for 14 days with up to 3 renewals if no one is waiting. Overdue charges are \$5/day for this item.

The Koboldt Trust is administered by Fifth Third Bank. Paul Koboldt a past President of The First National Bank of Effingham (now Fifth Third Bank) and his wife, Virginia, were lifelong residents of Effingham.
